CALL TO ORDER

The June 7, 2018 Regular meeting of the Jefferson Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Alan Loesch. Meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance  
Members present: Chairman Alan Loesch, Vice-Chair Dennis Morgan, Supervisor Keith Crum, and Secretary-Treasurer Robyn Loesch. Guests: Sheila Keiter, Brenda Osman, Mike Gustin.

COG REPORT –The June COG meeting has been moved to Millersburg Borough.

ROAD REPORT -

- We do not yet have a status update on the State's roadwork and paving project on Powell's Valley Rd. Sue Helm's office will be getting back to us with an update.
- Keith Crum reported that the DCCD came up and walked and measured Hemlock Road for a Dirt & Gravel Road Grant. They are recommending \$117,000.00 to fix the end of the road near Mountain House Road. We will find out tomorrow if we got the grant.
- Mowing is on hold right now, we are waiting for a part for the brush hog. A part has to be fabricated.
- Keith has ordered three more tons of cold-patch.
- On the Salt Shed, quotes will be here for the July meeting. We need to get the lease agreements from Atty. Laskowski. We are doing two separate agreements, one for building use and one for the salt shed.
- We also need to write up an intermunicipal agreement for our snow plowing in Rush Township.

OLD BUSINESS -

- The West Cross Road bridge is still on the PennDOT sponsored grant project list for 2020.

NEW BUSINESS –

- Dennis Morgan said that the Township's Facebook site is updated. It was discussed that we should send out a postcard mailing about the Facebook site.
- PSATS is supporting several pieces of legislation dealing with issues such as intermunicipal agreements, improving the Right-to-Know Law, and increasing the Prevailing Wage project minimum to \$500,000.
- Keith Crum proposed selling the old International truck on Municibid. Alan Loesch made a motion to use Municibid. Seconded by Dennis Morgan. All were in favor and motion passed 3-0.

ADJOURNMENT – Alan Loesch motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Dennis Morgan. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:57 P.M.
