ROAD REPORT – Keith Crum reported that:

- Keith has put down two loads of coldpatch from Hempt Brothers. He will call them to find out delivery prices.
- The lights are working on the tractor, it will need a new switch. Hammaker East is looking at starting the E&C project at the end of the month.
- The guiderail projects are finished on Back Rd and Middle Rd. Chemung will be sending a package of reflectors for the new guiderails.

- Keith will be working on a test stormwater hole to prevent gutter erosion on Hemlock Rd..
- The gutter area of a section of West Cross Road was widened.
- Keith would like to repair the edge of the road on the mountain (by Peterson's) before the E&C project.

- The Township will contact the Fire Company to get something in writing about our removal of the landscape timbers in their parking lot. This is in preparation for a paving project.
- There was another general discussion about potential new stop signs on Back Rd. and Carsonville Rd. We will contact the property owner near the proposed Back Rd. stop sign and post this information of our website and Facebook page.
- A letter was sent to the property owners on the lane across from the kennel, about improving the lane to limit debris washing onto the Back Rd.
- There is a meeting with the PennDOT on July 28th about the West Cross Rd bridge.
