ROAD REPORT

- February was a busy month, the trucks are all repaired. Springs were replaced on the International.

- The Township's portion of the costs for the PennDOT project bridge replacement on West Cross Rd. will be \$45,250. PennDOT is paying for the vast majority of the project. The contract was sent to Atty. Laskowski. We are filling out Business Partnership paperwork with the State. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried 3-0. Alan Loesch made a motion to approve Resolution #356-2021 to approve the Rimbusement Contract with the State. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in

favor. Motion carried 3-0. Alan Loesch made a motion to approve Resolution #357-2021 to approve him to sign the Business Partner documentation when we get it.

- Keith is now certified for Dirt & Gravel Road projects.
- We will contact PSATS for a sample driver CDL policy.
- Keith recommends we reorder 100 tons of salt through COSTARS for the 2021-22 season.

OLD BUSINESS We obtained a model stop sign ordinance from PSATS, so it will be ready when we finalize our plans and send it to Atty .Laskowski. No engineering is needed for stop signs at Ts.We are still looking at our opthins at the curve Y intersection of Carsonville and Middle Rd. We would still like to shave down the bank to increase sight distance.

NEW BUSINESS - COG will sponsor a flagging course on April 1 at Lykens Borough.
