CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS - Alan Loesch made a presentation about the Township project to name private lanes to bring them into compliance with current 911 address format. It is important that emergency services has a correct address to find people during an emergency. The Township is looking at naming lanes with two or more dwellings on a single lane/driveway. There are approximately eighteen private lanes that need to be named and addressed. The Township contacted residents and cabin owners to come to this meeting, or contact the Township by email. We hope to work with the residents to choose an acceptable lane name, and the Township will be buying and erecting the lane signs. The Halifax Postmaster also discussed the need to update addresses to an acceptable format, especially since all of the local mail is machine sorted in Harrisburg.

PUBLIC COMMENT – There was a general discussion by the Supervisors and the local citizens about the proposed address changes.

ADJOURNMENT – Alan Loesch motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Keith Crum. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:30 .P.M.
