- The SEO will be sending a report about the property on the mountain.

NEW BUSINESS

- Alan Loesch made a motion to sign the County Waze agreement that will let us notify Waze of planned road closures. Seconded by Keith Crum and all in favor. Motion passed 2-0.
- Alan Loesch made a motion to have the Roadmaster sign the PennDot Winter Maintenance agreement. We have not yet received our agreement. Seconded by Keith Crum and all in favor. Motion passed 2-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT Mike Gustin asked about building setback rules.

ADJOURNMENT – Alan Loesch motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Keith Crum. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:08 P.M.
