CALL TO ORDER

ROAD REPORT

- Alan Loesch made a motion to advertise a bid for single sealcoat and fog seal of an area of the Back Rd. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried 3-0.
- There was a discussion about the recent PennDOT request for a new Resolution for cost of the West Cross Rd. bridge project. Last year, Andrew Bomberger from Dauphin County had sent an email about the County helping with the cost overruns. The

Township cost is %5 of the project. The recent PennDOT project estimate has ballooned to over \$2.2 million. However, as there is no formal agreement in place with the County, Alan Loesch made a motion to not sign any new cost Resolution with PennDOT until we have confirmation on our exact Township costs. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried 3-0.

- The Girl Scout stormwater plan is still on hold.

NEW BUSINESS

- There was a short discussion about the next phase of the LVR pipe project. The Township intends to begin the grant paperwork for the next phase of seven pipes on the remaining segment of Carsonville Rd. We will ask Chris Hooper about the need for end-walls in the very steep area, and if plastic end walls would be a possibility.
- Alan Loesch made a motion to send a \$100 Donation to the Fire Company in lieu of funeral flowers for Fire Chief David Warfel. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried 3-0.
