OLD BUSINESS

- There us no new news about the Low Volume Rd. grant program for the next phase of Carsonville Rd. pipe replacement, DCCD is waiting for the State budget to be finalized.
- The West Cross Rd. bridge replacement project is still moving forward. The State is working on right-of-way acquisitions.

- The Supervisors will be meeting with Irv Snyder in October 17th to look at his problem with debris running into his pond.
- The County TISIP project – the Supervisors have prioritized the project items to have the bid stay within the budget. Priorities (first to last) pipes, guiderail at Andy Osman's, new guiderail area on the Back Rd.

NEW BUSINESS - The Supervisors had a discussion with the Fire Chief, Jason Faust about when/if any local burn ban needs to be enacted. Jason will contact DCNR for guidance and information. Jason also asked about the Comcast lines at the firehouse. Both the Township and the fire company have separate internet lines. The Township has a legacy complementary which also provided free TV access for the fire company TV in the meeting room.
