CALL TO ORDER

The January 5, 2026, Regular Meeting of the Jefferson Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:45 PM by Chairman Alan Loesch. Members present: Chairman Alan Loesch, Vice-Chairman Dennis Morgan, Supervisor and Roadmaster Keith Crum, Sec/Treas Robyn Loesch. Guests: David Quigley, Jason Faust.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

Alan Loesch made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 24, 2025 Special Meeting. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried 3-0. Keith Crum made a comment that he did not want to be paid for the short Special Meeting; all agreed with him.

Alan Loesch made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 18, 2025 Regular Meeting. Dennis Morgan seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried 3-0.

ROAD REPORT -Keith Crum gave an update:

- They have done a lot of snow removal
- The ice storm used a lot of material. He has ordered two loads of salt. One, is from Oceanport as he called but could not get through to American Rock Salt.
- The F600 was in for a wiring issue on the lights.
- He got fluid film from Messicks to keep connectors from freezing.

- The Freightliner heater switch stopped working and is being replaced.

OLD BUSINESS

- The West Cross Road bridge replacement project's right-of-way issue moves into the eminent domain phase. Linus Fenicle is representing the Township on this issue. Alan Loesch made a motion to pass Resolution #394-2026 giving him the authority as Chairman to sign the necessary documents for the Declaration of Taking in the condemnation proceeding for the Tier property easement. Seconded by Dennis Morgan. All in favor and motion passed 3-0.
- There is nothing new on the Carsonville Rd pipe replacement project. Chris Hooper will be meeting with Ed Fisher.
- Alan Loesch made a motion, seconded by Dennis Morgan, to now drop everything except the base bid from the TISIP project, due to constat cost escalations. All in favor and motion passed 3-0.
- There is nothing new on the Mandy Carl stormwater.

NEW BUSINESS -

- The dates were set for the remaining 2026 meetings.
- The Special Meeting on December 24, 2025, was to approve sending a letter of intent for the purchase of a new truck. The grant contract is not yet here from the State. We will put down the minimum deposit if necessary to hold the truck.
- Alan Loesch made a motion, seconded by Dennis Morgan to appoint Keith Crum to sign any and all necessary dealership and PennDot paperwork during the truck purchase process. All in favor and motion passed 3-0.
- There was a general discussion about the eventual sale of the Freightliner when the new truck is purchased. Jason Faust gave some insight into recent used truck prices. The truck will be offered for sale to neighboring municipalities for \$17,500. If there is no local interest, it will be put on Municibid.

ADJOURNMENT – Alan Loesch motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Dennis Morgan. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
