Re-organization Meeting

January 5, 2026

Alan Loesch, called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Present: Supervisors Alan Loesch, Dennis Morgan, Keith Crum, Robyn Loesch

APPOINTMENT OF POSITIONS

- A.** One motion was made by Alan Loesch, seconded by Dennis Morgan to appoint all the following for 2025. All in favor, 3-0.
1. Alan Loesch as Chairman
 2. Dennis Morgan as Vice Chairman
 3. Keith Crum as Roadmaster
 4. Jack Kerwin from the law firm of Kerwin & Kerwin as Township Solicitor.
 5. Brad Crum to serve as Chairman of the Vacancy Board.
 6. Brian McFeaters Enforcement Officer.
 7. Ryan Jorich as the Alternate SEO.
 8. Brenda Osman to serve as Emergency Management Coordinator
 9. Robyn Loesch as representative to the Upper Dauphin Council of Governments.
 10. Light Heigel as Township engineer.
 11. Light Heigel as Permit and Code Enforcement Officers
 12. Mid Penn Bank as the Township Financial Depository
 13. Meetings
 - Monthly meetings will be held on the first Thursday of each month except for and December which will be held the third Thursday of the month.
 - Meetings will start at 7:30 PM with an optional Work Session for the Supervisors that is open to the public but with no public participation. The Regular meeting will follow immediately after the Work Session.
 14. Certify all Supervisors and the Secretary as Delegates to the annual State Association Convention and appoint Alan Loesch as the voting delegate.
- B.** Wages & Bonding – One motion was made by Alan Loesch to approve the following wages and Treasurer's bond. Motion passed 3-0.
1. Wages for Labor
 - All plowing and labor: \$15.00/hour
 - Overtime: Time and one half will be paid for hours worked over (8) per day, and hours worked over (40) per week. Overtime must be approved by the Roadmaster before it is worked, except in the case of emergencies such as snow removal.
 - All supervisors are appointed to work in any capacity with the same recommended \$15.00/ hr wages proposed to be paid for all labor (Supervisor wages must be set by the Auditors).
 2. The Treasurers Bond set at \$275,000.

- C. Resolution #343-2019, which appointed Kaye Thoma as our voting delegate to the Dauphin County Tax Collection Committee and Alan Loesch as the alternate delegate, is still in effect so no vote was needed.
- D. Dennis Morgan made a motion to appoint Robyn Loesch as Secretary/Treasurer with the following pay and appointments. Second by Dennis Morgan. Motion passed 2-0 with Alan Loesch abstaining.
1. Motion to set the pay rate for the Secretary/Treasurer at \$840.00 (increase of 5%) payable at each regular monthly Township meeting for services performed during the previous month.
 - If the person appointed as Secretary/Treasurer changes, the incoming and outgoing persons shall be paid on a prorated basis based on the number of days each worked during the month when the change occurred.
 - If the Township receives a grant or emergency financial aid from County, State or Federal Government or from any other source and that grant or aid includes an allowance for administrative support, the Secretary/Treasurer shall be eligible for that administrative payment in addition to the normal monthly amount if the Supervisors appoint the Secretary/Treasurer as the person to perform that administrative work. (Note; The Supervisors may appoint anyone to perform the Administrative work, not just the Secretary/Treasurer.)
 2. The Secretary is appointed as the Township's Right to Know Officer.
- E. The existing fee schedules as set by Resolution #344-2019 were reviewed and no changes were proposed. Therefore, those fees remain in force and no vote was needed.

Alan Loesch made a motion to adjourn the reorganization meeting. Second by Dennis Morgan. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 PM.
