ROAD REPORT -Keith Crum gave an update:

- He called to have the fuel tank filled.
- We got in two more loads of anti-skid.
- The salt bin and the mix bin are filled.
- All of the equipment worked well during the last storm. The plow crew did a great job.

OLD BUSINESS

- The West Cross Road bridge replacement project - nothing new. Alan has been in contact with Leona Barr. Arrow is still working on the Tier easement.
- TISIP project – Keith got an email back from Raj Moola that Raj will be getting back to him with an update.
- There is nothing new on the Carsonville Rd pipe replacement project.
- There is nothing new on the Mandy Carl stormwater.

NEW BUSINESS -

- Alan Loesch made a motion to approve Resolution #395-2026 supporting the formation of a COG Regional EMS Services Authority. Seconded by Dennis Morgan and all were in favor. Resolution passed 3-0.
- Alan Loesch made a motion authorizing Ed Fisher to begin enforcement action (if needed) for the building permit necessary to bring the Miller property into compliance with Township ordinances. Dennis Morgan provided a written request to abstain from this vote. Keith Crum seconded the motion. Alan Loesch and Keith Crum are in favor; Dennis Morgan abstained. Motion passed 2-0.
- Alan Loesch made a motion, seconded by Dennis Morgan to approve Resolution #396-2026 for the Emergency Declaration for Winter Storm Fern. All in favor and motion passed 3-0.
- We are still waiting for the State grant check for the new truck. Everything is on hold at SEI until the State funding comes. The Freightliner will then be put out for bid on Municibid.
